Narma is a member of the United Nations.

« para 4 »

Both Ratvan and Amber ratified the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea in 1995.

« para 5 »

According to the Ratvan Fisheries Agency, illegal and unauthorized fishing costs the country about a billion US dollars annually.

« para 7 »

The term “Ratvan waters” in the Ratvan Fisheries Act shall mean Ratvan’s exclusive economic zone.

« para 8 »

Ratvan's Act on Punishment of Organized Crimes is an implementation act for the Convention against Transnational Organized Crime in 2000. In this Act, all the acts subject to the obligation to criminalize under the Convention are made criminal offences in the domestic laws of Ratvan. In addition, Ratvan has established all forms of jurisdiction referred to in Art 15 of the Convention.

The *RNS Lancer* had never issued an order to stop to the *Challenger* before the shooting. The shooting caused some damage on the vessel, but there was no injury among the crewmembers on board.

It is not known whether the *Challenger* and its Captain Zandal has been involved in the activities of Badar.

The gunshot from *RNS Lancer* did not hit the *ACG Esda*.

The "Act" in line 5 shall mean the Ratvan Fisheries Act of 1983.

After being moored in port for several days, the *Challenger* was seized in accordance with the Fisheries Act, confiscated by the decision of the court and blown up on Ratvan's offshore area.

Both Amber and Ratvan have not signed nor ratified the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children, Supplementing the United Nations Convention Against Transnational Organized Crime.
