Moot Problem
Supplement

We are releasing the moot problem supplement of “The Case Concerning the Investment in the State of Rambald” as follows.

-Paragraph 2

No dispute regarding the Rambald–Tantalons bilateral investment treaty has ever been referred to international dispute settlement procedures.

-Paragraph 4

Amand Minerals was incorporated under the law of Akiras and continues to be based therein.

The Rambaldic government was not involved in any part of concluding the contract regarding mining at tantalum mines in Rambald between Amand Minerals and Rambald Minerals Development Organization (RAMDO).

The contract regarding mining provided that the parties shall begin negotiations for renewal of the contract by July 2012.

-Paragraph 5

The new Rambaldic government was legally established through election.

-Paragraph 6

The use of child labor in mining activities by Amand Minerals was illegal under the law of Rambald.

In October 2011, Amand Minerals officially committed to take preventive measures against child labor. It also announced in November 2011 that it would replace its board members and pay compensation to the victims.

The Rambaldic government launched a crackdown on small and medium domestic enterprises which were suspected of the illegal use of child labor. None of the suspected enterprises has a contractual relationship with RAMDO.

-Paragraph 7

After RAMDO issued the statements, Amand Minerals continued its mining business.

-Paragraph 11

Achil Chemical was incorporated under the law of Akiras and continues to be based therein.

One Achil Chemical factory located in the State of Domile was subject to an administrative sanction in 2012.

-Paragraph 12

The environmental minister reported that the Achil Chemical factory in Rambald discharged environmental pollutants into local neighborhoods and violated Rambaldic laws.

-Paragraph 13

The major power companies which cancelled power supply contracts with the Achil Chemical factory, as well as other enterprises which refused to supply the Achil Chemical factory with raw materials, are all private enterprises.

-Paragraph 15

“The Broadcasting Guideline” is not binding under Rambaldic law.

Regarding the media which reported the results of the investigation the environmental scholars conducted on the request by Achil Chemicals, the Ministry of Broadcasting in Rambald conducted the investigation based on interviews with those broadcasting entities.

Among the environmental scholars participating in the investigation, there were no Akiras and Rambaldic nationals.

-Paragraph 16

Ralfa bought the Achil Chemical factory in Rambald in accordance with Rambaldic law.

After acquiring the factory, Ralfa issued a press release on the acquisition

The “normal market value of the factory” means the price of the factory prior to March 2013.

-Paragraph 21

Both Akiras and Rambald are United Nations member states.
